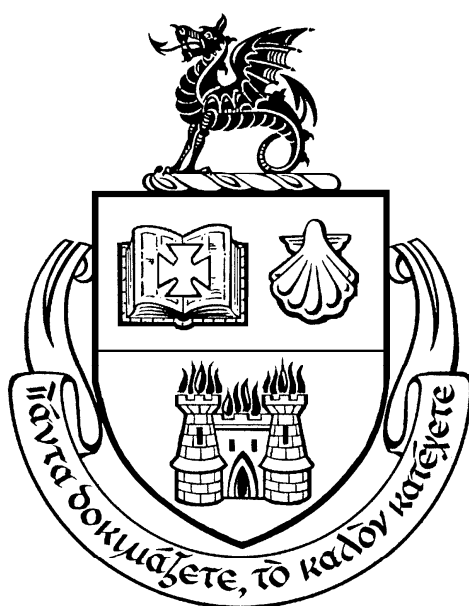

## BOYS' UNIFORM LIST

(Valid for school year 2011/2012 only)

*Pupils are admitted only on the understanding that they support the College Uniform policy.*

*Articles of clothing other than those itemised below are not acceptable.*

**EACH ARTICLE WORN IN SCHOOL, INCLUDING ALL UNDERCLOTHING, SHOES AND EQUIPMENT MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH THE OWNER'S NAME.**

**ALL ITEMS ON THIS LIST, EXCEPT THOSE MARKED OPTIONAL (\*), ARE COMPULSORY.**

#	<b>College Tie</b>	<i>6<sup>th</sup> Year may wear the Past Pupils' tie.</i>
#	<b>College Pullover</b>	<i>Pupils in 5<sup>th</sup> Year and 6<sup>th</sup> Year are permitted to wear the Senior Pullover, as a distinctive symbol of their status in the school.</i>
	<b>Trousers (2)</b>	<i>Plain Mid-Grey, flannel like (not smooth), ordinary slacks, excluding stripes or jean style (e.g. patch pockets or decorative stitching).</i>
	<b>Belt</b>	<i>Black leather belts <b>only</b> are acceptable.</i>
	<b>Socks</b>	<i>Dark Grey, Navy or Black.</i>
#	<b>Shirts (4)</b>	<i>Shirts (light blue with embroidered crest) must be purchased in Rita's.</i>
#	<b>Aertex Shirts (4)</b>	<i>Pale blue short sleeved aertex shirts (without tie) may be worn during the summer term until 30<sup>th</sup> September. <b>Must be purchased in Rita's.</b></i>
	<b>Shoes</b>	<i>Ordinary Black Leather Shoes (suede or two toned shoes, runners etc. are not acceptable).</i>
#	<b>College Jacket</b>	<i>(A reflective armband etc., is recommended for <b>ALL</b> pupils).</i>
#/*	<b>College Blazer</b>	<i>Plain Navy with Crest. (<b>Compulsory for Boarders</b>) (It should be noted that pupils, when representing the school at various functions or events such as sports tours, choirs etc., may be expected to have blazers).</i>
#/*	<b>College Scarf</b>	<i>The new College Scarf can be purchased from Rita's.</i>

Please note:

1. The College Jacket is suitable for all students; only motor cyclists may wear a black or navy leather jacket. (A reflective armband etc., is recommended for **ALL** pupils).
2. Scarves, if worn, must be College scarves; this includes motor cyclists.
3. Scarves, gloves and jackets are not permitted during class hours. Gloves and other accessories must be plain navy or black.
4. All trousers must be plain mid grey ordinary slacks. No denims, cords, canvas, jeans style, baggy style or scout trousers are permitted.
5. All shoes must be black leather water resistant and ordinary style. No fashion extremes including suede or heavy boots will be allowed. Two tone shoes are unacceptable.
6. T-shirts **must not** be visible if worn under shirts and should not be worn with the summer uniform.
7. If there is a doubt regarding any item of uniform, dress or appearance the appropriate Head of Uniform or Year Head should first be consulted prior to purchase in order for approval to be given.
8. It should be noted that pupils, when representing the school at various functions or events may be expected to wear blazers, which are not to be borrowed from boarders.
9. 6th Years are encouraged to wear the Past Pupils' tie.

### BOARDER BOYS' SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION

(Valid for school year 2011/2012 only)

*The need to ensure that all clothing and personal items are named cannot be over emphasised. The Head of House requires that name tapes should be sewn in obvious places. Any additional items purchased during the term must be named **immediately**. Parents are asked to co-operate fully in this, as much clothing is being lost, and if found, cannot be claimed because of non-compliance with this rule.*

**NOTE:** As storage space is limited, parents are reminded that boys should limit non-uniform items.

**Suitcases should be clearly marked, preferably on the outside, with the owner's name.**

- 6 Pairs **Dark Grey, Navy or Black** Socks
- 2 Pairs Sleep Wear
- Underwear
- Towels
- 2 Fitted Sheets and 2 Duvet Covers (**minimum**)
- 1 Duvet
- 2 Pillow Cases
- 1 Dressing Gown
- 1 Pair Bedroom Slippers (**for house wear only**)
- 4 Handkerchiefs
- 2 Coat Hangers with trouser rail
- 2 Weekend Bags (**1 for games gear; 1 for travel**).
- 6 Large Safety Pins for Socks to laundry
- Laundry bag.
- Hair Brush and Comb
- Nail Brush, Toothbrush and Toothpaste
- Instant shoe shine/cleaner
- Umbrella (**optional**)
- Tuck Box (**optional, but strongly recommended**). Due to limited storage, dimensions should not exceed L = 19" x B = 11.5" x H = 9.5". Lock and key for dorm locker for personal possessions. *Spare key for each is to be lodged with the Head of House.*
- Mouth guard/Gum shield (**compulsory**), **available from the Head of House**

Items for Laundry tend to be away for 3 days and therefore quantities stated are the minimum necessary.

Casual clothes of good taste may be worn after school and at weekends.

While pillows are available from the College, for the purposes of hygiene it is recommended that pupils bring their own.

Duvets are not supplied.

#	<b>Skirts (navy) (2)</b>	<i>Special design only: All girls must have the College skirt <u>knee length</u>.</i>
#/*	<b>Trousers (navy)</b>	<i>Special design only – available only from Rita's</i>
	<b>Tights or Socks</b>	<i>Plain Navy tights (no less than 40 denier) or Navy knee length socks</i>
#	<b>Blouses/Shirts (4)</b>	<i>Red College blouse (must be purchased from Rita's). Pale Blue Aertex short-sleeved shirts, may be worn during the summer term until 30<sup>th</sup> September (must be purchased from Rita's).</i>
	<b>Shoes</b>	<i>Ordinary Black or Navy Leather Shoes. Ankle boots are forbidden, (suede or two toned shoes, runners, mules, deck shoes, slingbacks, patent, platforms or ballet pumps are <b>not acceptable</b>). <b>Heels should be block heels <u>no higher than 5 cm</u> (no Stilettos allowed)</b>. Flat shoes with good support are advised.</i>
#	<b>College Jacket</b>	<i>(A reflective armband etc., is recommended for <u>ALL</u> pupils).</i>
#/*	<b>College Blazer</b>	<i>Plain Navy with Crest. (<b>Compulsory for Boarders</b>) (It should be noted that pupils, when representing the school at various functions or events such as sports tours, choirs etc., may be expected to have blazers).</i>
#/*	<b>College Scarf</b>	<i>The new College Scarf can be purchased from Rita's</i>

### **Please Note:**

1. All pullovers (except the Senior pullover worn by 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Year) must have correct school stripes (red, white, red, on navy ground) at neck; these should be knitted or crocheted into the garment. (Tacking or running stitches are not accepted). No other insignia should appear on the pullover. **Pullovers should not be torn at the cuffs.**
2. Regulation school skirt and blouses, as available from the official suppliers must be worn.
3. Blouses and aertex shirts should be purchased from the school suppliers. T-shirts **must not** be visible if worn under blouses and should not be worn with summer uniform.
4. The College Jacket is suitable for all Years. *A reflective armband etc., is recommended for ALL pupils.*
5. Scarves, if worn, must be College scarves; this includes motor cyclists.
6. Scarves, gloves and jackets are not permitted during class hours. Gloves and other accessories must be plain navy or black.
7. Footwear:  
Dark navy shoes are acceptable as an alternative to black. Ankle boots are forbidden. Two tone shoes, runners, mules, deck shoes, slingbacks, platforms, patent or ballet pumps are unacceptable. **Heels should be block heels no higher than 5 cm (no Stilettos allowed)**. Flat shoes with good support are expected.
8. If there is a doubt regarding any item of uniform, dress or appearance the appropriate Head of Uniform or Year Head should first be consulted prior to purchase in order for approval to be given.
9. It should be noted that pupils, when representing the school at various functions or events, may be expected to wear blazers, which are not to be borrowed from boarders.
