## Uniform and Appearance Policy

1. Wesley College has a compulsory uniform for all students.
2. The following is the official uniform of the College:

### Boys:

Wesley College Jacket  
Wesley College Pullover  
Wesley College Shirt  
Wesley College Tie  
Mid-Grey Trousers  
Plain Black Leather belt, if required  
Plain Black Leather Shoes  
Dark Grey, Navy or Black Socks  
Wesley College Scarf (optional)

Wesley College Blazer

*(for use when at official events or when representing the College)*

Students in 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Year may wear the Senior Pullover  
Boys in 6<sup>th</sup> Year may wear the Past Pupils Tie

### Girls:

Wesley College Jacket  
Wesley College Pullover  
Wesley College Blouse  
Wesley College Skirt/Trousers  
Plain Black or Navy Leather Shoes  
Plain Navy Socks or Tights  
Wesley College Scarf (optional)

Wesley College Blazer

**Only the official College Uniform, purchased from the official supplier, is acceptable.**

**Please refer to additional requirements regarding uniform on the appropriate Uniform List.**

If in doubt about the suitability of items (eg shoes) contact the Head of Uniform, Year Head, Deputy Principal or Principal.

3. **Complete uniform must be worn in school, on the way to and from school and at all official College functions.** A detailed list of all clothing is available for both boys and girls. Parents are requested to read the appropriate uniform list and ensure that their son/daughter has all the

additional shirts and trousers/skirts as indicated to enable complete uniform to be worn at all times.

4. Students are expected to have all necessary sports wear and equipment as detailed in the Sports Wear and Equipment List and as communicated to students by PE and Games staff from time to time.
5. All pupils are expected to wear the College Uniform with pride. Untidy dress and appearance is not acceptable. Torn or frayed clothing is not acceptable. Clothes should fit properly to ensure a dignified appearance.
6. Students who are not in full uniform, or who are untidily dressed may be sent home.
7. All articles of clothing should be clearly named. While the school will endeavour to assist any pupil who mislays items of clothing, students are expected to look after their own clothing, and are ultimately responsible for their own property.
8. Extreme hairstyles or extreme colouring are not permitted. Hair should look neat, clean and tidy. 0, 1 or 2 blades are not allowed. Boys should be clean-shaven. The decision of the Principal or Deputy Principal in the interpretation of these rules will be final.
9. Girls only may wear one pair of small studs or sleepers for pierced ears - to be worn only in ear lobes. Excessive jewellery, or make-up will not be permitted. Fake tan is not acceptable. Jewellery should be minimal and discreet. The decision of the Principal or Deputy Principal in the interpretation of these rules will be final.

All other items of jewellery are liable to confiscation. Parents may personally reclaim items by arrangement.

10. College jackets or hoodies may be worn to and from school, but not during class.
